### New Building Project Update

The parish's finance committee has asked and been granted a \$25,000.00 loan from the diocese to complete three Spring building projects. The first project is to fix the foundation wall at the North-side entrance of the church which has cracked and there is water seepage below the stairwell. The second project is to resurface the parish hall with new tiles and to fix any areas which the wood underneath has softened. The final project is to fix the wooden fence which encloses the second-floor rectory deck. The bishop has graciously exempted the fundraising for these projects from the annual calculation of the diocesan administrative expense (the tax which all parishes pay the diocese based on annual revenue). Therefore, please use your building fund envelopes each month. The monies in that fund will be used for the repayment of the diocesan loan. Thank you for your generosity and your participation in helping to keep our church in tip top shape! --- Fr Sam



## Pastoral Pondering

In today's gospel, Jesus is again in Jerusalem. It is there that he prophesies of his coming death and also of his resurrection. It's here that he reminds his followers what is in store for them as well. Life as a follower of Jesus will not be easy. It will mean that each follower will have to participate in the great paschal mystery - by suffering in our own way, dying to ourselves and our own agendas, and rising again to new life through the Spirit. To do this means a life of service to Christ, following in his footsteps, making his priorities our own, and not giving up when danger or trouble or hardship may come our way. Such steadfastness to the Gospel and love of the Lord is what being a follower of Christ means. So we can ask ourselves if we are ready to undergo the paschal mystery. Are we prepared to suffer if necessary, so that the Lord's kingdom may be further expanded? Are we willing to face difficult and seemingly impossible obstacles to making the gospel known and embraced by others? Are we willing to die to our own agendas, our sinfulness, and our pride in order to allow Christ to enter more fully into our consciousness and to give us the insight to know what the Spirit is inviting us to do in the here and now of our everyday existence? Are we convinced that all our efforts, empowered by that same Spirit, are not in vain, that there is a promised and definite new life to come, not only to ourselves, but to all who believe? Are we hopeful that the Lord can bring about this new life in us by his grace, poured out upon us at Baptism and nourished each week by Holy Eucharist? Are we ready to make Jerusalem our destiny, just as surely as Jesus made it his own and embracing all that happens along that path? These are some pastoral ponderings for each of us to consider as we continue our journey to Easter dawn.
