New Building Project Update

Building Fund

On behalf of the parish's finance committee has asked and been granted a \$25,000.00 loan from the diocese to complete three Spring building projects. The first project is to fix the foundation wall at the North-side entrance of the church which has cracked and there is water seepage below the stairwell. The second project is to resurface the parish hall with new tiles and to fix any areas which the wood underneath has softened. The final project is to fix the wooden fence which encloses the second-floor rectory deck. The bishop has graciously exempted the fundraising for these projects from the annual calculation of the diocesan administrative expense (the tax which all parishes pay the diocese based on annual revenue). Therefore, please use your building fund envelopes each month. The monies in that fund will be used for the repayment of the diocesan loan. Thank you for your generosity and your participation in helping to keep our church in tip top shape! --- Fr Sam

Pastoral Pondering

In today's first reading from the Prophet Isaiah, we hear what the fate of the messiah will be: He will be struck; he will be spit upon; he will have God as his helper! He will not be put to shame therefore, because God is on his side. We also hear that the messiah will set his face like flint to accomplish the suffering and death that are necessary to bring about redemption of the world. From these prophecies, we can see the passion of the Christ revealed. We can also see Christ's steadfast resolve to rouse the people to faith in God and to restore to them the hoped for realization of the Kingdom of God, not in some far off distant time, but in the here and now, in the moment that it takes a believer to come to the knowledge of the truth. Do we have that same steadfast resolve to rouse others to faith in Christ? Do we have that same bold-faced determination to set our faces like flint, to accomplish all that God asks of us—whether it be easy or hard, whether it require suffering or not? That is the message of the Passion of the Christ. He did not flinch in his determination to accomplish all that God asked of his life, giving 100% to his Father and surrendering his life into God's hands. If we could achieve such determination, then our Lenten season will definitely have been a blessing to us and to our world! A pastoral pondering as we enter Holy Week!
