Pastoral Pondering

Jesus says in today's gospel, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age. (Mt 19-20)" We can imagine this mandate being boldly fulfilled after Pentecost, more strongly than it was before, because now, the disciples had the power of the Holy Spirit inner-vating their every thought, word and deed. We do what we do by the authority of Jesus who empowers us to do it! We baptize because Jesus told us to do so, in order to increase adherents to the faith! The process towards baptism begins first by evangelizing those who will be baptized (or in our modern day, their parents) so that they can share their faith with their children. Faith is caught, not taught. When we baptized, we allow the triune God to invite the believer into the very life of God! God as a trinity, is a communal God, one who shares power equally between Father, Son and Holy Spirit. One person of the Trinity can never act on his own, but always with the full cooperation of the other two. That image of Trinity is also a great image of how our relationships should be characterized by a mutuality and a respect and a love which transcends space and time! Once the baptism is completed, the individual has a whole lifetime to learn about the Gospel and the teachings of the church, and will do so with the grace that comes from the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit that now lives inside of them. A pastoral pondering as we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity.
