Pastoral Pondering

There is an episode of *Touched by an Angel* in which Wynonna Judd is in grief at the impending loss of her son. Being a song writer in the episode, she just can't get herself to finish the song. It's only as her son's death quickly approaches that she realizes that, by finishing the song, she will be bringing glory to God and to her son who leaves this earth as she and the choir sings. The song's second verse and refrain reminds me of Pentecost every time I hear it: "From the mountains to the valleys, from the rivers to the sea, every hand that reaches out, every hand that reaches out to offer peace, every simple act of mercy, every step to kingdom come, all the hope in every heart, will speak what love has done!" And the refrain is just as beautiful! "For as long as I shall live, I will testify to love, I'll be a witness in the silences when words are not enough! With every breath I take I will give thanks to God above! For as long as I shall live, I will testify to love." Pentecost is the culmination of our striving to testify to love, not just to one another, but to all whom the Lord places along our life's path! It's about being unafraid and joyful in telling others the wonders Christ has done in our lives and the wonders He promises to do in their lives too! All it takes is FAITH and a supportive Christian community to give a believer the right start in the right direction to give glory to God and for their own lives, to testify to love! All praise to the Lord who with the Father, sends us the Holy Spirit to testify to God's love for sinful humanity! Keep the flame of the Spirit alive every day of your life! Nominations for Parish Pastoral Council

Joyce Risdale, our parish pastoral council chairperson's term has ended and we thank her for her faithful and generous service on the parish pastoral council for four years. Nominations are now open for the new parish pastoral council chairperson, whose term is two years, renewable once. To be eligible, you must be a baptized adult member of the parish in good standing and faithful to the teachings of the Roman Catholic Church. It would be a benefit if the chairperson also was able to receive electronic communications via email. This person will work closely with the pastor, the vice-chairperson and the recording secretary to set and implement the agenda of each parish pastoral council meeting.

If you know someone whom you think would be able to represent the parish in this capacity, please submit his/her name in the locked wooden box in the back of the church, using the form also at the back of the church. Nominated members will be contacted by the pastor to see if they would let their name stand for the position. At the end of May, we will ask the Holy Spirit to select the new chairperson by drawing a name out of a basket which will have the names of all those who have agreed to accept the position. The deadline for submissions is May 25th.

We are also ready to accept nominations for another parish representative-at-large. We thank Anna Schiafone for her service in representing all of you. This position involves bringing to the parish councillors any concerns or ideas that parishioners may have, which will improve community life, the apostolate, and evangelical outreach of the parish. The position is for one year, renewable once. Please submit names in the locked wooden box in the back of the church for this position as well using the form at the back of the church. Nominated members will be contacted by the pastor to see if they would let their name stand for the position. At the end of May, we will ask the Holy Spirit to select the new representative-at-large by drawing a name out of a basket which will have the names of all those who have agreed to accept the position. The deadline for submissions is May 25th.
