## Pastoral Pondering

Our first reading today from the Book of Genesis tells us, in the literary genre of a fable, an important truth that God wants us to know. Sin entered the world because humans chose to reject God and wanted instead, to make themselves to be God. All sin comes down to this basic rejection of God's authority over us and our desire to usurp the power and authority which God ought to have in our lives. Their nakedness in the story symbolizes our being found out by God. What did God find out? God discovered that the humans whom He had created to reflect his very image in the word, whom He created to love and live with him for all eternity, didn't reciprocate that love and desire for an eternity with God. They wanted to go it alone. They wanted to make up their own morality. They wanted to live for this world only and not to consider the world which lasts forever. We know many people who share those same desires, don't we? We know many people who have replaced the place reserved in their heart for God alone, with some created thing, some finite pleasure or promise. Christians need to reach out to them with the message of the Gospel! Christians need to practice what they preach too! Christians need to turn to God once more and rely on the power of baptism to give us a new life! Hence, the need for a redeemer. Hence, the need for a messiah! Hence, the need for Jesus Christ to enter into the world, to heal the brokenness found in human nature and to show us the way things could be with God at the center of our every thought, word, and deed! A pastoral pondering as we enter the 10<sup>th</sup> Week of Ordinary Time.
