Pastoral Pondering

Isaiah says in our first reading, "I have set my face like flint and I know that I shall not be put to shame, he who vindicates me is near." Isaiah 50: 7b-8a What Isaiah is saying, is that he's tough. He's not going to use God as a crutch, and complain to God night and day about the troubles he's having accomplishing his prophetic mission, given to him by God. Rather, he's going to be strong like flint to stand against anything and anyone who may doubt God's presence or action in the world. This is the kind of person whom God is hoping all of us will become as well ---persons who are able to persevere in the midst of trying times.---persons who are stable in their faith and will not let it be shaken from its foundations.---persons who are willing to let God condition us and our lives by the hurdles that we sometimes have to face, so that we will be stronger and more assured of God's presence in our lives. That's what it means to set our faces like flint. We can ask God's grace each day to be more resolved to follow him, more resolved to hear his word and to generously respond to it. We can ask God's grace to motivate us to be unconcerned of the sneering and the skepticism of others when they ask us why we follow Christ and are a part of God's Church. We can ask for the conviction of Isaiah to know that God will not leave us high and dry to our own resources but will show us how we can convert the hardened heart and in the process, fulfill our vocations in life. --- A pastoral pondering as we enter this 24th week in Ordinary Time.
