A Pastoral Pondering on Pope Francis' Letter on Sexual Abuse

Pope Francis, in addressing the sexual abuse in the Church wrote a letter to the People of God, in August 2018. In it, he wrote, "If one member suffers, all suffer together with it" (1 Cor 12:26). *These words of Saint Paul forcefully echo in my heart as I acknowledge once more the suffering endured by many minors due to sexual abuse, the abuse of power and the abuse of conscience perpetrated by a significant number of clerics and consecrated persons. Crimes that inflict deep wounds of pain and powerlessness, primarily among the victims, but also in their family members and in the larger community of believers and nonbelievers alike. Looking back to the past, no effort to beg pardon and to seek to repair the harm done will ever be sufficient. Looking ahead to the future, no effort must be spared to create a culture able to prevent such situations from happening, but also to prevent the possibility of their being covered up and perpetuated. The pain of the victims and their families is also our pain, and so it is urgent that we once more reaffirm our commitment to ensure the protection of minors and of vulnerable adults.*" As your pastor, I agree totally with Pope Francis' sentiments, as do all the priests that I know. It is up to each and every one of us to ensure that such abuses never occur again and that we are accountable to each other. It is up to each and every one of us as well, to support our bishops in implementing policies that will ensure a thorough screening for all aspirants to the priesthood and that those who are in our seminaries are formed to be holy priests, on fire with the Holy Spirit and ready to serve as celibate men. It is up to each and every one of us to ensure that those who have been victimized by clergy are reached out to with compassion and sensitivity and that they are given all that they need to assist with the healing process, however long it may take. Though it is never easy facing sin in our church, a big step toward repentance is acknowledging what we have done wrong in the past and find ways that we can do better in the future so as to make sure it never happens again. 


