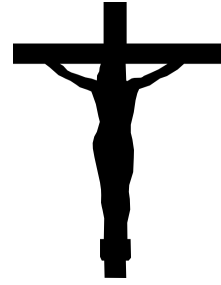

### **"Christ's Kingdom of peace and eternal life:**
