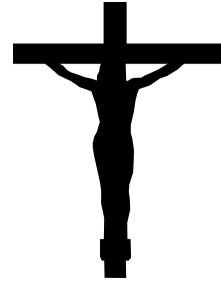

God has lifted up the lowly (The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary)

Mary is a model of faith and hope for us. The Gospel of Luke reveals the presence and power of the Holy Spirit in Mary's life. When Elizabeth and Mary greeted one another, they were filled with the Holy Spirit and with a joyful anticipation of the fulfillment of God's promise to give a Savior.
