The first weekly meeting of the Adult Faith Formation Group will be held in St. Andrew the Apostle church hall on Wednesday February 9 from 7:00 PM to 8:30 PM. You are invited to join us on a journey of faith through stages of questioning, discernment of God's call, reflection on the Gospel and prayer, instruction and discussion, in a community building experience with members of the Parish. This is a time of preparation for a person who has never been baptized; for someone who has been baptized in another denomination and wishes to become a Catholic; and, for someone who has been baptized as a Catholic but who has not received any instruction in the faith. The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, (RCIA), is a process prepared by the Church, through which a parish prepares and welcomes new members into the Christian community. Jesus performed the miracle of the great catch of fish. This incident tells us an important truth about how God works in and through each of us for his glory.
