Jesus is the door to the kingdom of heaven:

Jesus surprised His listeners by saying that one's membership as a people who have entered a covenant relationship with God does not automatically mean entry into the everlasting kingdom of God. Second, Jesus asserts that many from the Gentile (non-Jewish) nations would enter God's kingdom. God's invitation is open to Jew and Gentile alike. But Jesus warns that we can be excluded if we do not strive to enter by the narrow door. What did Jesus mean by this expression? The door which Jesus had in mind was Himself. I am the door; if anyone enters by Me, he will be saved. God sent His only begotten Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, to open the way for us to have full access to the throne of God's grace (favor and blessing) and mercy (pardon for our sins).

Through Jesus' victory on the cross, He has freed us from slavery to sin and hurtful desires and addictions and He has made us sons and daughters of God and citizens of His heavenly kingdom.
