Jesus the Lamb of God – The Savior of the World:

John calls Jesus the Lamb of God and thus signifies Jesus' mission as the One who redeems us from our sins. John points to Jesus' saving mission - to offer up his life as the atoning sacrifice for our sins. John recognized that Jesus was the perfect unblemished lamb offered by the Father in heaven as the one and only sacrifice that could cancel the debt of sin, and free us from death and the destruction of body and soul in hell.

How can we be certain that Jesus is truly the Christ, the Son of the living God? The Holy Spirit makes the Lord Jesus Christ known to us through the gift of faith. God gives us his Spirit as our helper and guide who opens our hearts and minds to receive and comprehend the great mystery and plan of God - to unite all things in his Son, our Lord Jesus Christ (Ephesians 1:10).

Do we want to grow in the knowledge and love of Jesus Christ? Let us ask the Lord to pour his Holy Spirit upon us to deepen our faith, hope, and love for God and for the plan he has for our lives.
