Jesus and the Samaritan woman:

Jesus treated the Samaritans, the sworn enemies of the Jews, with great kindness and respect. He reached out to Samaritan woman, thus risking ritual impurity and scorn from his fellow Jews. He treated the woman like he would treat one of his friends. He demonstrated the universality of the gospel both in word and deed. No one is barred from the love of God and the good news of salvation. There is only one thing that can keep us from God and his redeeming love - our stubborn pride and willful rebellion.

What is the point of Jesus' exchange with the Samaritan woman about water? Water is a source of life and growth for all living things. The image of "living water" is used throughout the scriptures as a symbol of God's wisdom, a wisdom that imparts life and blessing to all who receive it.

The water which Jesus spoke of symbolized the Holy Spirit and his work of recreating us in God's image and sustaining in us the new life which comes from God. The life which the Holy Spirit produces in us makes us a "new creation" in Jesus Christ. Do we thirst for God and for the life of the Holy Spirit within us?
