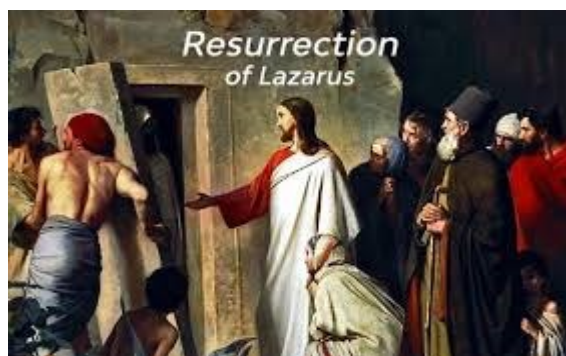

The hope of our resurrection:

Accomplishments for 2022

- Under the Leadership of then Grand Knight, Ron Spina, Council 6074 achieved the highest honours for a Council in 2022, the Star Council Award. 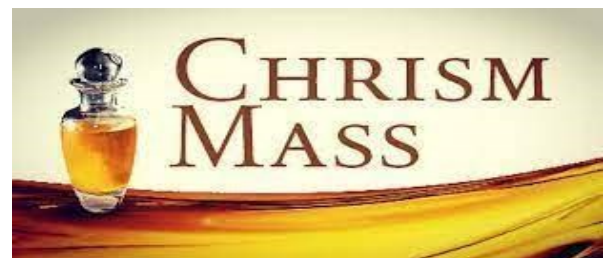
