### HOLY BIBLE

### 3rd Sunday of Easter Reflection

### Do we recognize the Risen Lord in his word and in the breaking of the bread?

Jesus rebuked the disciples on the road to Emmaus for their slowness of heart to believe what the Scriptures had said concerning the Messiah. They did not recognize the risen Jesus until he had broken bread with them.

St. Augustine of Hippo (354-430 AD) reflects on the dimness of their perception: They were so disturbed when they saw him hanging on the cross that they forgot his teaching, did not look for his resurrection, and failed to keep his promises in mind. Their eyes were obstructed, that they should not recognize him until the breaking of the bread. And thus, in accordance with the state of their minds, which was still ignorant of the truth - that the Christ would die and rise again, their eyes were similarly hindered. It was not that the truth himself was misleading them, but rather that they were themselves unable to perceive the truth.

The Risen Lord is ever ready to speak his word to us and to give us understanding of his ways. Do we listen attentively to the Word of God and allow his word to change and transform us?






