## Jesus revealed the glory of his resurrection:

Fr. Peter Chrysologus ( $5^{th}$  Century priest) remarked: "To behold the resurrection, the stone must first be rolled away from our hearts". Do we know the joy of the resurrection? The disciples disbelieved until they saw the empty tomb.

- Americans spend \$1.9 billion on Easter candy. That's the second biggest candy holiday after Halloween.
- The first story of a rabbit (later named the "Easter Bunny") hiding eggs in a garden was published in 1680.
- "The White House Easter Egg Roll" event has been celebrated by the President of the United States and their families since 1878.
- The naming of the celebration as "Easter" seems to go back to the name of a pre-Christian goddess in England, Eostre, who was celebrated at the beginning of spring.
- Eggs represent new life and rebirth, and it's thought that this ancient custom became a part of Easter celebrations. In the medieval period, eating eggs was forbidden during Lent (the 40 days before Easter) so on Easter Sunday, tucking into an egg was a real treat!
- The three main Easter colors are **purple, white and gold**. Purple and violet hues are typically used during the Lenten season in the lead-up to Easter. Easter Sunday's most prominent colors are usually white and gold to represent the holiness and triumph of the resurrection of Jesus.
