

The Pentecost Sunday - Reflection

The gift of Pentecost:

The outpouring of the Holy Spirit, and the spiritual gifts and blessings of God - are made possible through the death, resurrection, and ascension of the Lord Jesus. After his resurrection Jesus "breathed" on his disciples and gave them the Holy Spirit. With the gift of the Holy Spirit a new creation begins. God recreates us for his glory. Jesus' gift of peace to his disciples was more than an absence of trouble. His peace included the forgiveness of sins and the fullness of everything good.

The Lord Jesus offers each one of us the gift and power of his Holy Spirit. He never refuses to give his Spirit to those who ask with expectant faith. Jesus instructed his disciples to ask confidently for the gift of the Spirit: "If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will the heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!" (Luke 11:13). Do we thirst for God and for the abundant life he offers through the gift of his Spirit?

Everything we need to know about Pentecost

- The word 'Pentecost' comes from the Greek word "pentēkostē," which means "fiftieth," referring to the fact that the holiday occurs 50 days after Easter.
- Pentecost is an important holiday in the Christian faith because it marks the moment when the Holy Spirit came upon the Apostles and empowered them to spread the message of Jesus Christ to the world.
- This event drew a crowd of people who were amazed to hear the Apostles speaking in their own languages. Peter then gave a powerful sermon, and about 3,000 people were baptized that day.
- Pentecost is a time to remember those in need and to **donate to the poorest of the poor**.
- Pentecost is a great day for spiritual baptism or anointing by the Holy Spirit. It enables you to have a spiritual connection with God.




