

5th Sunday of Easter - Reflection

I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life:

The disciples were surprised that Jesus was going to his Father's house and would return to take them with him. Jesus proclaims I am the Way (John 14:6). He accompanies us on our daily journey and watches over us as the good shepherd who leads and sustains us each step of the way. Are we in step with the Lord and do we trust in his guiding hand for our lives?

Jesus proclaims that he is the Truth (John 14:6). The truth which Jesus proclaims has power to set us free from ignorance, deception, and sin. Moral truth requires more than mere words or ideas because the person who speaks to them must be true - true in thought, speech, deed, example, and action. Jesus embodies the truth in his person.

Jesus proclaims that he is the Life (John 14:6). He not only shows us the path of life (Psalm 16:11); he gives the kind of life which only God can give - abundant life that lasts forever. Is there any trouble, fear, or distraction that keeps us from the perfect peace and joy of a life surrendered to Jesus Christ?




