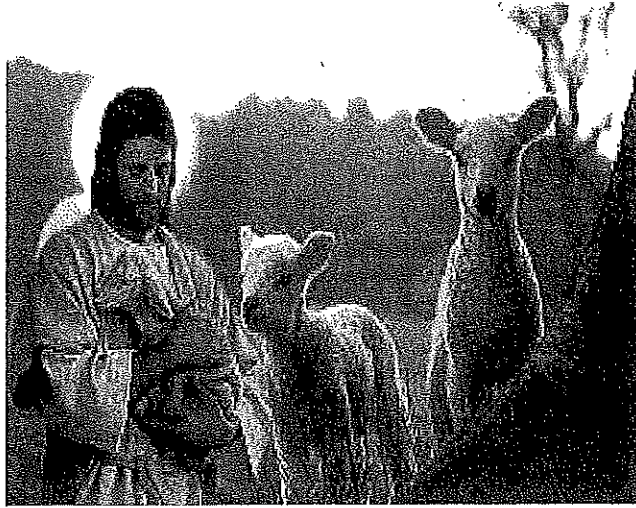

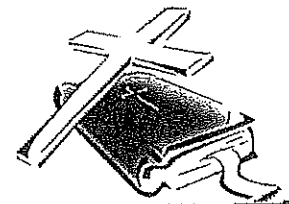

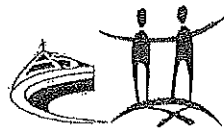

Converting both heart and will to do what is good and pleasing to God:

The "rebellious" son told his father to his face that he would not work for him. But afterwards he changed his mind and did what his father commanded him.
