We have been "stamped" with God's image and likeness:

What do we owe God and our neighbor? Scripture tells us to give to everyone whatever is their due and “to owe no one anything, except to love one another” (Romans 13:6-8). The Jewish authorities sought to trap Jesus in a religious-state issue.

Jesus avoided their trap by confronting them with the image of a coin. In a certain sense, the coin was regarded as the personal property of the ruler. Where the coin was valid the ruler held political sway over the people. Since the Jews used the Roman currency, Jesus explained that what belonged to Caesar must be given to Caesar.

This story has another deeper meaning as well. We too, have been stamped with God's image since we are created in His own likeness - "God created man in His own image ..male and female He created them." We rightfully belong, not to ourselves, but to God who created us and redeemed us in the precious blood of His Son, our Lord Jesus Christ. Paul the Apostle says that we are to present our bodies as a living sacrifice to God. Do we give to God what rightfully belongs to him?
