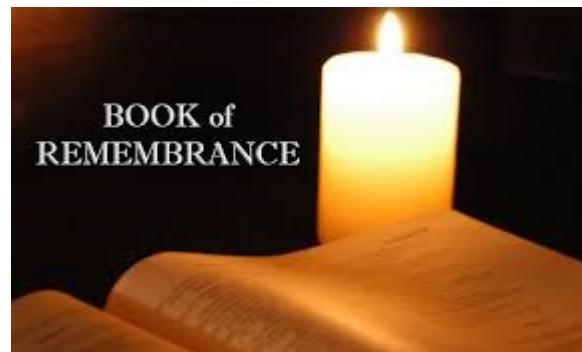

## **FIRST RECONCILIATION / FIRST HOLY COMMUNION**

**(Grade 2 and higher)**

**Dear Parents: In order for your child to receive these sacraments you must:**

- 1) complete a registration form and provide a copy of the Baptismal certificate if NOT baptized at St. Andrew the Apostle. Registration form can be found on our website “sacrament forms standrewtheapostlesudbury”**
- 2) Registration form will NOT be accepted after FRI. NOV. 3, 2023**
- 3) Attend a Nov. weekend Mass (either Sat. 4:30pm or Sun. 10am) for your child to be accepted as a candidate and receive a special blessing.**
- 4) Children must complete all assignments given and bring them to the ONE meeting on Tues. Nov. 28th at 6PM. This meeting is mandatory.**
- 5) The Sacrament of Reconciliation will take place Sat. Dec. 2nd at 10:30am at the church.**
