#### Called to hear and obey the Word of God:

John broke the prophetic silence of the previous centuries when he began to speak the word of God to the people of Israel. His message was like the message of the Old Testament prophets who chided the people of God for their unfaithfulness and who tried to awaken true repentance in them. Among a people unconcerned with the things of God, it was his work to awaken their interest, unsettle them from their complacency and arouse in them enough good will to recognize and receive Christ when He came.

Jesus tells us that John the Baptist was more than a prophet. John was the voice of the Consoler who was coming. He completed the cycle of prophets begun by Elijah. What the prophets had carefully searched for, and angels longed to see, now came to completion as John made the way ready for the coming of the Messiah, God's Anointed Son, the Lord Jesus Christ. With John the Baptist, the Holy Spirit begins the restoration to humanity of the "divine likeness", prefiguring what would be achieved with and in the Lord Jesus.
