


# Interesting facts about the Transfiguration of Our Lord Jesus Christ


- The word "transfiguration" comes from the Latin roots trans- ("across") and figura ("form, shape"). It thus signifies a change of form or appearance.
- The three who are privileged to witness the event are Peter, James and John, the three core disciples.
- Luke states that Jesus took the three "on the mountain to pray." This mountain is often thought to be Mount Tabor in Israel, but none of the gospels identify it precisely.
- Christ's Transfiguration aims at strengthening the apostles' faith in anticipation of his Passion: the as-
- cent onto the 'high mountain' prepares for the ascent to Calvary.

  Moses and Elijah represent the two principal components of the Old Testament: the Law and the Prophets. Moses was the giver of the Law, and Elijah was considered the greatest of the prophets. The fact that these two figures "spoke of his departure, which he was to accomplish at Jerusalem" illustrates that the Law and the Prophets point forward to the Messiah and his sufferings.




