

The colt was a sign of peace. Jesus enters Jerusalem in meekness and humility, as the Messianic King who offers victory and peace to his people. That victory and peace would be secured in the cross and resurrection which would soon take place at the time of Passover.

Augustine, the great 5th century church father, comments on the significance of Jesus' entry into Jerusalem: "The master of humility is Christ who humbled himself and became obedient even to death, even the death of the cross. Thus he does not lose his divinity when he teaches us humility."

Jesus Christ came to bring us the kingdom of God. He is the true King who offers peace, joy, and everlasting life for those who accept his kingship. Does the King of glory find a welcome entry in your heart and home? Do our walls echo with the praise of his glory?

Interesting facts about Palm Sunday

- The name Palm Sunday comes from the fact that as Jesus entered Jerusalem the people of the city waved palm branches and placed palm leaves on the ground to jubilantly welcome Jesus.
- The palm branch, or palm frond, is a symbol of victory, triumph, peace, and eternal life originating in the ancient Near East and Mediterranean world.
- Red or purple are appropriate for Palm Sunday. During Holy Week, purple is used until the church is stripped bare on Maundy Thursday, the church remains stripped bare on Good Friday and Holy Saturday, though in some places black might be used on those days.
- The word hosanna (Latin osanna, <u>Greek</u> ὑσαννά, hōsanná) is from <u>Hebrew</u> הושיעה־נא, הושיעה נא hôšî â-nā and related to Aramaic ōsha nā) meaning 'save, rescue, savior.'




