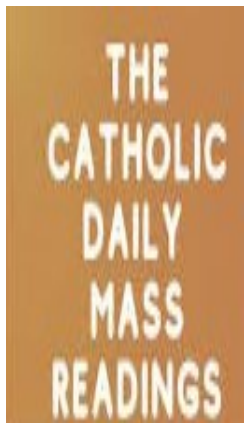

The door to heaven and key to paradise is through the cross :

The Gospel accounts attest to the reality of the resurrection of Jesus from the grave. Jesus goes to great lengths to assure his disciples that he is no mere ghost or illusion. He shows them the marks of his crucifixion and he explains how the Scriptures foretold his death and rising.

The centrality of the Gospel message is the cross - but fortunately it does not stop there. Through the cross Jesus defeated our enemies - death and Satan and won pardon for our sins. His cross is the door to heaven and the key to paradise. The way to glory is through the cross. When the disciples saw the risen Lord they disbelieved for joy!

Jesus shows us the way and he gives us the power to overcome sin and despair, and everything else that would stand in the way of his love and truth. 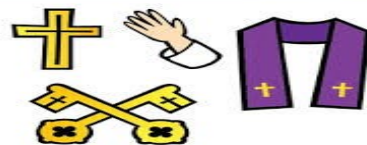

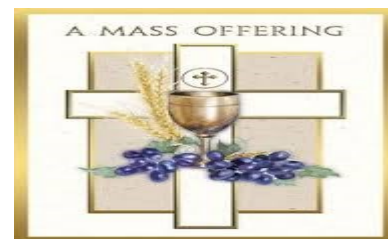

Prayer of St. Gertrude

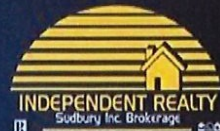
Eternal Father, I offer Thee the Most Precious
