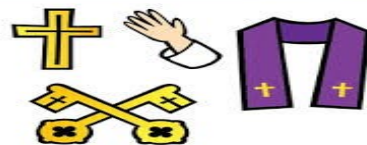

Prayer of St. Gertrude

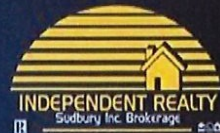
Eternal Father, I offer Thee the Most Precious
