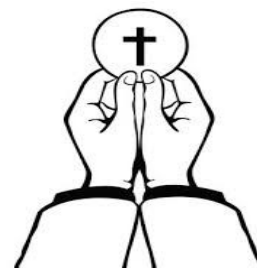

Jesus says: I am the living bread that came from heaven.

When the Lord Jesus commands his disciples to eat his flesh and drink his blood, he invites us to take his life into the very center of our being. That life which he offers is the very life of God himself. Jesus' death on the cross, his gift of his body and blood in the Supper, and his promise to dine again with his disciples when the kingdom of God comes in all its fullness are inseparably linked.

Jesus instructed his disciples to "do this in remembrance of me". When we receive from the Lord's table we unite ourselves to Jesus Christ, who makes us sharers in his body and blood. Ignatius of Antioch calls it the "one bread that provides the medicine of immortality, the antidote for death, and the food that makes us live for ever in Jesus Christ." The principal fruit of receiving the Eucharist is an intimate union with Christ. As bodily nourishment restores lost strength, so the Eucharist strengthens us in charity and enables us to break with disordered attachments to creatures and to be more firmly rooted in the love of Christ. Do we hunger for the "bread of life?"

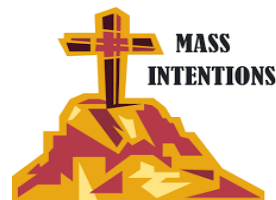

FEAST OF CORPUS CHRISTI

- ♦ The Feast of Corpus Christi **originated in 1246 when Robert de Torote, bishop of Liège**, ordered the festival celebrated in his diocese. He was persuaded to initiate the feast by St. Juliana, prioress of Mont Cornillon near Liège (1222–58), who had experienced a vision.
- ♦ This year marks the 760th celebration of the Feast of **Corpus Christi** (Latin for “**Body of Christ**”) – also known as the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.
- ♦ **Corpus Christi** is primarily celebrated by the **Roman Catholic Church** but it is also **included in the calendar of some Anglican churches**. The city of Corpus Christi, in Texas, was named after the day.
- ♦ In some countries in the world, Catholic churches still celebrate the festival, not only with a Mass, but also with a procession that carries the consecrated wafer through the streets as a **public statement** that the **sacrifice of Christ was for the salvation of the whole world**.
- ♦ Some of the **Corpus Christi** symbols include: **Bread and Wine (or Plate and Chalice)**, **a bunch of grapes, vine, peacock feeding on grapes** and any symbol of the Eucharist.
