The gift of Pentecost:

After his death and resurrection, Jesus promised to give his disciples the gift of the Holy Spirit. He said to them: *“Receive the Holy Spirit!” Jesus knew that his disciples would need the power of the Holy Spirit to carry out the mission entrusted to them. The gift of the Holy Spirit was conditional upon the ascension of Jesus to the right hand of the Father.*

Just as Jesus was anointed with the Spirit at the beginning of his ministry, so the disciples needed the anointing of the Holy Spirit to carry out the mission entrusted to them by Jesus. The Holy Spirit is given to all who are baptized into Jesus Christ to enable us to live a new way of life - a life of love, peace, joy, and righteousness. The Holy Spirit fills our hearts with the love of God, and He gives us the strength and courage we need to live as faith-filled disciples of the Lord Jesus.

The gift of Pentecost - the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, and the spiritual gifts and blessings of God - are made possible through the death, resurrection, and ascension of the Lord Jesus. His peace included the forgiveness of sins and the fullness of everything good. Do we want the power to live a faith-filled life as a disciple of Jesus? Let us ask the Father to fill us with the power of His Holy Spirit.

Facts about the Feast of Pentecost

- ◆ The word “Pentecost” (from the Greek word pentēkostē, meaning “fiftieth”)⁴ comes from the Greek name for a **harvest festival that is also known as the “Feast of Weeks.”** This unique feast occurred 7 weeks after Passover (49 days), culminating with the actual feast on day 50 (hence, the New Testament term “Pentecost”).
- ◆ It commemorates the **descent of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles and other disciples** following the Crucifixion, Resurrection, and Ascension of Jesus Christ (Acts, chapter 2).
- ◆ Pentecost marks the **beginning of the Christian church's mission** to the world.
- ◆ Pentecost is a powerful demonstration that God is with us. The outpouring of the Holy Spirit in Acts 2 is a reminder that **God will never leave us alone to carry out his will for our lives.** Regarding Jesus' ministry on this earth, it is easy to see God's presence with us.
- ◆ In modern times, **the Pentecost experience continues to have relevance for the Church.** The outpouring of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost is a reminder of the power of the Holy Spirit in the lives of believers. The Holy Spirit is not limited by time, culture, or geography but is active and present today.
- ◆ The Pentecost feast lasts **three days** and starts on Sunday, which is known as “Trinity Sunday.”


