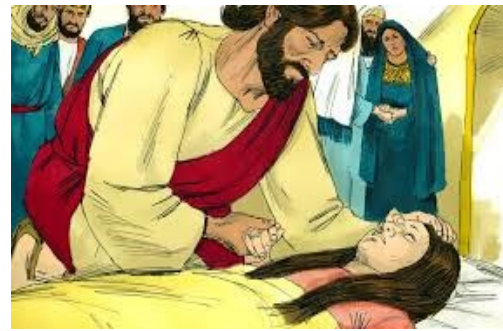

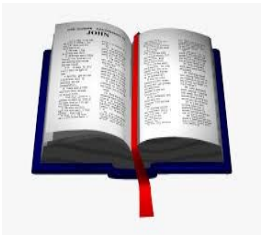

### **The woman who took heart in Jesus:**

Do we approach the Lord Jesus with expectant faith or with skeptical doubt? People in desperate or helpless circumstances were not disappointed when they sought Jesus out. What did the elderly woman who had suffered miserably for twelve years expect Jesus to do for her? And what did a grieving father expect Jesus to do for his beloved daughter who was at the point of death? Jesus gave hope where there seemed to be no human cause for it because his hope was directed to God. He spoke words of hope to the woman (*Take heart, daughter!*) to ignite the spark of faith in her (*your faith has made you well!*).

Jesus also gave supernatural hope to a father who had just lost a beloved child. It took considerable courage and risk for the ruler of a synagogue to openly go to Jesus and to invite the scorn of his neighbors and kin. Even the hired mourners laughed scornfully at Jesus. Their grief was devoid of any hope. Nonetheless, Jesus took the girl by the hand and delivered her from the grasp of death.

In both instances we see Jesus' personal concern for the needs of others and his readiness to heal and restore life. In Jesus we see the infinite love of God extending to each and every individual as he gives freely and wholly of himself to each person he meets. Do we approach the Lord with confident expectation that he will hear our requests and act?

## Parish Installs Hearing Loop for those that are hearing impaired

A hearing loop system has been installed in both the church and the parish hall. Hearing loop systems, also known as audio frequency induction loop systems (or AFILS), wirelessly transmit sound signals from a sound source (microphone) directly to the telecoil receiver (T-coil) in a hearing aid or cochlear implant. The system eliminates most background noise and greatly improves understanding of speech and music. Additionally, the sound received is customized by each user's unique hearing instrument.

To hear clearly, individuals simply switch their devices to the T-coil program and automatically receive clear customized sound.

If you have a hearing aid or cochlear implant please contact your audiologist to verify that your device has a T-coil (most modern hearing aids do) and how to activate it.

This hearing loop system was made possible by a very generous grant from the Canadian Hard of Hearing Association (covered 78% of cost) and funds raised by our participation at Delta Bingo and Gaming.

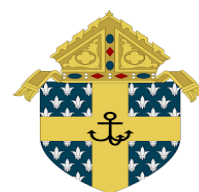
