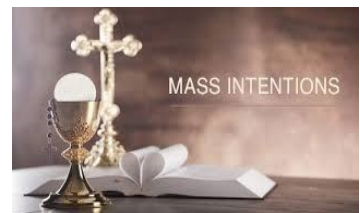

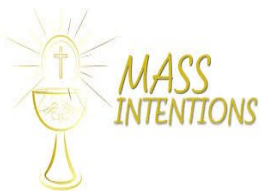

Happy Valentine's Day

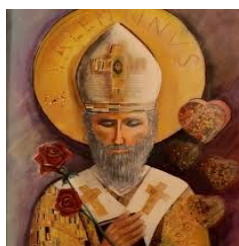


Valentine's Day falls on **February 14**, the name day of two saints, **St Valentine of Rome and St Valentine of Terni.**


In pre-Christian times, the middle of February was a time of pagan fertility festivals in Europe and allegedly the time when birds chose a mate.



St. Valentine of Rome: Saint Valentine, officially known as Saint Valentine of Rome, is a third-century Roman saint widely celebrated on February 14 and commonly associated with "courtly love." Although not much of St. Valentine's life is reliably known, and whether or not the stories involve two different saints by the same name is also not officially decided, it is highly agreed that St. Valentine was martyred and then buried on the Via Flaminia to the north of Rome.



St Valentine of Terni: Saint Terni is the city of St. Valentine. Although he is celebrated in many parts of the world as the protector of lovers on 14 February, Terni has an extraordinary bond with St. Valentine, so much so that he is its patron saint. He was martyred by decapitation performed secretly along the Via Flaminia, near Rome, after being arrested, "guilty" of having urged some young men to convert to Christianity.

Sacraments

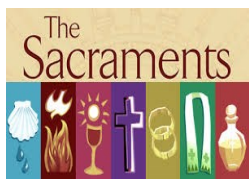
Sacrament of Baptism: Celebrated every Saturday at 11.00am.
