

Spiritual preparation in the forty days of lent:

Sunday Mar. 16th

When Jesus went out into the wilderness to fight the devil's temptation, He was led by the Holy Spirit. Jesus did not rely on His own human strength and will-power for overcoming temptation. The Lord Jesus is ever ready to pour out His Spirit upon us so that we may have the courage we need to repent, turn away from our sins and to reject the lies and deceits of Satan.

The 40 days of Lent is the annual retreat of the people of God in imitation of Jesus' forty days in the wilderness. We are called to journey with the Lord in a special season of prayer, fasting, almsgiving, repentance and renewal as we prepare to celebrate the feast of Easter, the Christian Passover. The Lord gives us spiritual food and supernatural strength to seek His face and to prepare ourselves for spiritual combat and testing. We, too, must follow in the way of the cross in order to share in the victory of Christ's death and resurrection. As we begin this holy season of preparation and renewal, let us ask the Lord for a fresh outpouring of His Holy Spirit that we may grow in faith, hope and love and embrace His will more fully in our lives.




