

Facts about the Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ

- According to tradition, the Ascension took place at Mount Olivet near Bethany.
- Augustine's work appears to be the first written evidence of the observance of the feast day on Ascension Thursday, although he traces its origin to the apostles. John Chrysostom, Gregory of Nyssa and the Constitution of the Apostles also make reference to the feast.
- There are several liturgical customs tied to the Ascension: the use of torches in liturgical procession; the blessings of beans and grapes as a symbolic feast for the dead in heaven; the use of processional banners with images of a lion and at his foot a dragon, signifying Christ's triumph over evil; the elevation of a figure of Christ through the roof of the church.
- ♦ The Ascension of Jesus serves as His proper enthronement, fulfilling the offer that Satan made to Him in the wilderness (Luke 4:5-7).




