

#### Hope in God and His merciful help:

Ezra 9: 5-9 | Luke 9: 1-6

Thursday Sept. 25th Haggai 1: 1-8 | Luke 9: 7-9

In the parable of the rich man who refused to help the beggar named Lazarus Jesus paints a dramatic scene of contrasts - riches and poverty, heaven and hell, compassion and indifference, inclusion and exclusion. We also see an abrupt and dramatic reversal of fortune. Lazarus was not only poor and a beggar, he was also sick and unable to fend for himself. He was "laid" at the gates of the rich man's house.

The dogs which licked his sores probably also stole the little bread he got for himself. Dogs in the ancient world symbolized contempt. Enduring the torment of these savage dogs only added to the poor man's miseries and sufferings.

The rich man treated the beggar with contempt and indifference, until he found his fortunes reversed at the end of his life! In God's economy, those who hold on possessively to what they have, lose it all in the end, while those who share generously receive back many times more than they gave away.

The name *Lazarus* means *God is my help*. He did not lose hope in God. The rich man served wealth rather than God. In the end the rich man became a beggar! Those who put their hope and security in the kingdom of heaven will not be disappointed.




