

God's words for the poor and the rich:

The Gospel reminds us that God has the last and definitive word over rich and poor. We have plenty of guidance on what God expects of us. We have the prophets like Amos, the scriptures, the social teaching of the church, the preaching and example of Christ (the One who came back from the dead) and the witness of the saints. This should focus our attention and inform our priorities.

Our faith compels us to be committed to working for justice and against poverty. Poverty in its broadest sense includes the lonely, the sick, bereaved, those trapped in addiction or anxiety and those unable to forgive.

Our gifts are not for hoarding or self-indulgence. The name of Abraham is mentioned, a reminder that we have a covenant responsibility to each other. God's covenant is with an entire people which is one family. (2 Sam 7:8-17). Pope Francis says: "I ask all people of goodwill to help build a culture of encounter, solidarity and peace."

We are given vision and take our direction from God and this helps us to act out of love. Love is sensitive, attentive, proactive, generous and relieves suffering. Be aware of the Lazarus' in our own communities...they may need our help in this life and we may need their help in the next.

THINKING ABOUT BECOMING A MEMBER OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH?

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the process is which adult men and women become part of the Catholic Church. Through its witness, service and catechesis, the whole parish community offers the invitation and support necessary for men and women to be welcomed as members of the community.

Adults who are not yet baptized are accepted into the process as catechumens and prepare to receive the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist) at Easter each year.

Those already baptized in another Christian tradition are welcomed as candidates for full communion and prepare to be received into the Catholic Church at a suitable time. A team of Catechists journeys with the catechumens and candidates for a number of months, meeting on the second, third, and fourth Sundays of each month

following the 10 am Mass.




