
"Let us come before His presence with thanksgiving." (Psalm 95:2)



The Holy Spirit helps us to grow in expectant faith:

What did Jesus mean when He said to His disciples that our *faith can move trees* and *mountains* as well. For our faith to be effective it must be linked with trust and with obedience - an active submission to God and a willingness to do whatever he commands. Do we trust in the grace and strength which God freely gives to help us resist temptation and to overcome obstacles in doing His will?



Mass Intentions






