

He was called Jesus:

What's the significance of a name? For the Jewish people the giving of a name had great importance. When a name was given it represented what that person should be in the future. A Jewish male child was named at the time of circumcision, eight days after birth. This rite was instituted by God as an outward sign to single out those who belonged to the Chosen People.

In fulfilment of this precept, Mary's newborn child is given the name Jesus on the eighth day according to the Jewish custom. Joseph and Mary gave the name Jesus because that is the name given by God's messenger before Jesus was conceived in Mary's womb. This name signifies Jesus' identity and His mission. The literal Hebrew means “**the Lord saves.**”

The name Jesus signifies that the very name of God is present in the person of His Son who became man for our salvation. The Apostle Peter exclaimed that there is no other name under heaven given among mortals by which we must be saved. In the name of Jesus demons flee, cripples walk, the blind see, the deaf hear and the dead are raised. His name is exalted far above every other name.

The name Jesus is at the heart of all Christian prayer. It is through and in Jesus that we pray to the Father in the power of the Holy Spirit. Many Christians have died with one word on their lips, the name of Jesus. Do we exalt the name of Jesus and pray with confidence in His name?

Consecration to the Holy Family on the Feast of the Holy Family

The Knights of Columbus invite every family of our parish to actively participate in the Consecration to the Holy Family, which will be held at our parish during all of the masses on the Feast of the Holy Family, during the weekend of December 27th and 28th. Families today face many struggles, both through cultural pressure and through the personal struggles that accompany family life. Despite these struggles - and partly as a result of conquering them - families have great capacity for love and joy, a joy that is strengthened through the peace and truth found in Christ. To assist families in living out this joy of Christ, Knights of Columbus Supreme Chaplain Archbishop William Lori has composed a prayer through which families may come together to consecrate themselves under the protection of the Holy Family. In this prayer, we ask for the aid or intercession of the perfect son Jesus Christ, Mary the perfect mother and Joseph who is a model for every father. There are a number of ways we could prepare for the Consecration: Pray together as a family, Perform acts of kindness and charity, Attend Reconciliation and Intentionally fast from something.

Prayer to the Holy Family

O Lord Jesus, You lived in the home of Mary and Joseph in Nazareth.

There You grew in age, wisdom and grace as You prepared to fulfill Your mission as our Redeemer. We entrust our family to You.

O Blessed Mary, you are the Mother of our Savior. At Nazareth you cared for Jesus and nurtured Him in the peace and joy of your home. We entrust our family to you.

O Saint Joseph, you provided a secure and loving home for Jesus and Mary and gave us a model of fatherhood while showing us the dignity of work.

We entrust our family to you.

Holy Family, we consecrate ourselves and our family to you. May we be completely united in a love that is lasting, faithful and open to the gift of new life.

Help us to grow in virtue, to forgive one another from our hearts and to live in peace all our days. Keep us strong in faith, persevering in prayer, diligent in our work and generous toward those in need. May our home,

O Holy Family, truly become a domestic church where we reflect your example in our daily life. Amen. Jesus, Mary and Joseph, pray for us!
